**Q1** The candidates for President are Democrat Hillary Clinton and Republican Donald Trump. If the election were today, who would you vote for?

**Q2** The candidates for U.S. Senate are Democrat Deborah Ross and Republican Richard Burr. If the election were today, who would you vote for?

**Q3** The federal minimum wage has been \$7.25 an hour since 2009. Do you strongly support, somewhat support, somewhat oppose or strongly oppose raising the federal minimum wage?
