



## New Hampshire Survey Results

**Q1** Under a new federal rule, people who earn less than \$47,000 a year will be guaranteed time-and-a-half overtime pay when they work more than 40 hours a week. 54,000 more New Hampshire residents will be eligible for overtime pay as a result. Do you strongly favor, somewhat favor, somewhat oppose or strongly oppose this proposal?
