



## Ohio Survey Results

**Q1** The candidates for President this fall are Democrat Hillary Clinton and Republican Donald Trump. If the election were today, who would you vote for?

*Hillary Clinton*..... 46%  
*Donald Trump*..... 42%  
*Not sure*..... 12%

**Q2** The candidates for U.S. Senate are Democrat Ted Strickland and Republican Rob Portman. If the election were today, who would you vote for?

*Ted Strickland*..... 39%  
*Rob Portman*..... 48%  
*Not sure*..... 13%

**Q3** The federal minimum wage has been \$7.25 an hour since 2009. Do you strongly support, somewhat support, somewhat oppose or strongly oppose raising the federal minimum wage?

*Strongly support*..... 48%
