



Pennsylvania Survey Results

Q1 Under a new federal rule, people who earn less than \$47,000 a year will be guaranteed time-and-a-half overtime pay when they work more than 40 hours a week. 459,000 more Pennsylvanians will be eligible for overtime pay as a result. Do you strongly favor, somewhat favor, somewhat oppose or strongly oppose this proposal?
